The Bridge Scholarship is a four-year financial aid package awarded annually to a high school senior, male or female, from any one of the high schools, public or private, located in Mecklenburg County.

The Bridge Scholarship will be presented annually to the individual who can best present his or her need for financial aid in order to achieve a specific goal or participate in a particular program at any accredited college or university in the United States of America. There are no minimal requirements, academic, athletic or extracurricular; however, each applicant must be accepted to their chosen institution prior to the award of any financial aid.

Applicants must present their intentions in a clear, concise and cogent manner what their goals are for the upcoming four-year period, how they plan to achieve those goals and why they have chosen the particular program or institution they plan on attending.

- A combination of written submissions and alternative media will be accepted, using the same parameters described above
